BACKGROUND

Inspired by the 3MT competition developed by the University of Queensland, FCAL's Lightning Talks consist of 5-minute talks on on-going research tailored to a general, non-specialized audience.



INSTRUCTIONS

- Limited to a maximum of 5 minutes.
- One single static slide.
- Slide is to be presented from the beginning of your talk.
- No transitions, animations, or 'movement', and no additional electronic media.

GUIDELINES

- Avoid jargon and specialized language.
- Explain concepts important to your research.
- Highlight the outcomes of your research, and the desired outcome.



MORE TIPS

- Know what you want your audience to take away from your presentation.
- Try to leave the audience with an understanding of what you're doing, why it is important, and what you hope to achieve.
